

- Have access to a VET training environment to complete post-course assessments (where required by electives).
- Have access to a mentor who holds TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training or Assessment or a higher level adult education qualification (where required by electives).

Delivery Options

1. Live Class

Duration

You have 12 months from course commencement to complete this qualification.

To complete this qualification you must demonstrate competency in a total of 12 units. 6 of these units are core and 6 are electives, of which 3 must be selected from Group A. The electives chosen represent a broad understanding and best practice for VET trainers and allows for a selection of two specialist streams
